Backcountry Programs

Let Whistler / Blackcomb's experienced ACMG (Association of Canadian Mountain Guides) take you on a tour of the fabulous back country of Whistler Resort, using skins and touring bindings for skiers and split-boards for snowboarders.

Cross-Country Skiing

More than 28 km (17.5 miles) of track-set cross-country trails wind through scenic Lost Lake Park, Chateau Whistler Golf Course and Nicklaus North Golf Course, providing different routes for all levels of skier.

Home of the 2010 Olympic and Paralympic Games, Whistler Olympic Park in Callaghan Country offers 90 km (56 miles) of cross country ski trails, groomed for both classic and skate skiing.

Dog Sledding

Experience one of the most ancient forms of travel over snow by riding in a sled pulled by a pack of dogs through the old growth forest of the Callaghan Valley.

Heli or Cat-Skiing / Snowboarding

It's your choice! Heli-skiing / snowboarding provides the perfect activity for intermediate to advanced skiers and snowboarders looking to add a thrilling new dimension to their vacation. Whilst Cat-skiing / snowboarding offers pristine powder in all weather conditions.

Ice Climbing

Ever dreamed of climbing up a frozen waterfall of ice? Ice climbing areas extend from Whistler to Lillooet with courses offered to teach you the basics of the sport.

Ice Skating

Enjoy indoor ice skating or drop-in ice hockey at the NHL-sized ice surface at Meadow Park Sports Centre. Skate rentals are available at the arena.
